

**2015 ANNUAL REPORT**

**TOWN OF LA GRANGE COLLECTION SYSTEM**

**PERMIT: WQCS00148**

The Town of LaGrange operates a wastewater collection system under permit WQCS00148, issued by the ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT COMMISSION, N.C. DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (DEQ). This system consists of approximately 18 miles of gravity sewer lines, 6 miles of pressure sewer, 4 miles of force main, 59 simplex pump stations, and 14 duplex pump stations, and all associated piping, valves, and appurtenances necessary to operate a wastewater collection system for the Town of La Grange.

During the year, 2015, this collection system was operated in compliance with all regulations applied to it by NCDEQ. The Town of La Grange had no SSO's (Sanitary Sewer Overflows), meaning that no wastewaters escaped from the system. If there was a spill of a thousand or more gallons or any reaching surface waters, The NC Division of Environmental Quality would be contacted by the Town of La Grange about the overflow and would work with DEQ to correct the problem.

Our 14 duplex pump stations are inspected weekly and our simplex stations are inspected as needed. Each of our duplex pumping stations has two pumps that alternate in operation and have a backup generator or bypass pumping capability to operate in case of power failure.

Wastewater collected by this system is pumped to the Town of La Grange wastewater treatment plant where it is treated and discharged into the Tributary of Moseley Creek.
